DETAILS: ENTRY FEE IS \$10. - ONE WORK PER ARTIST - TWO DIMENSIONAL WORK ONLY - MAXIMUM SIZE IS 36 INCHES HEIGHT OR WIDTH - WORK MUST HAVE BEEN COMPLETED WITHIN THE LAST THREE YEARS AND NOT EXHIBITED PREVIOUSLY IN AT ANY CAL EXHIBIT - WORK MUST EITHER BE FRAMED OR MUSEUM/GALLERY WRAPPED AND WIRED FOR HANGING - ENTRY FORM MUST BE AFFIXED TO THE REAR UPPER LEFT CORNER - WATERCOLORS (EXCEPT IF ON CANVAS), PASTELS AND DRAWINGS MUST BE UNDER GLASS - WORK MUST BE DRY - ARTWORK MUST REMAIN ON DISPLAY FOR THE DURATION OF THE EXHIBIT - ORIGINAL ART ONLY.
